

# COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION

of 8.8.2022

**on the financing of the individual measure in favour of Venezuela for 2022**

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU),

Having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 110 thereof,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2021/947 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 June 2021 establishing the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument – Global Europe, amending and repealing Decision No 466/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU) 2017/1601 and Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 480/2009<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Article 23(3) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In order to ensure the implementation of the individual measure in favour of Venezuela for 2022, it is necessary to adopt a annual financing decision, which constitutes the annual work programme for 2022. Article 110 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 ('the Financial Regulation') establishes detailed rules on financing decisions.
- (2) The envisaged assistance is to comply with the conditions and procedures set out by the restrictive measures adopted pursuant to Article 215 TFEU<sup>3</sup>.
- (3) The action provided for in this Decision contribute to climate mainstreaming in line with the European Green Deal and the inter-institutional agreement.
- (4) The Commission has adopted the Regional Multiannual Indicative Programme for the period 2021-2027<sup>4</sup>, which sets out the following priorities: protecting and promoting human rights, human dignity and inclusion; promoting civic values, conflict prevention and resolution, and democratic participation; and support to community resilience, strengthening sustainable access to basic services, local productive capacities/income generation, supporting the fight against the environmental degradation caused by the extractive industries and promoting sustainable socio-economic management of natural resources.
